

## CHAMPIONS GATE GOLF CLUB International Course

1. **LIFT, CLEAN & PLACE (LCP):** When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less in the player's own fairway, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and play from this relief area [ball becomes in play once addressed]:
  - Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
  - Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: Within one club-length from the reference point.
  - Limits on Location of Relief Area: Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in the general area.
2. **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS:** Footprints in bunkers and waste areas shall be deemed Ground Under Repair. All paved cart paths shall be deemed Immovable Obstructions and located in the General Area. The ChampionsGate **"BLUE POLE"** rule is NOT in effect.
3. **PENALTY AREAS:** In the absence of solid red or yellow penalty area boundary lines, all areas on the course beyond the first cut of rough **on any hole** shall be deemed Lateral Penalty Areas. The Penalty Areas shall include any sand areas and "Effluent Water Disposal Areas" there.
4. **SPECIAL PROVISIONAL BALL ALLOWANCE ON HOLE #6:** On Hole #6, for balls thought to be lost in any Penalty Area, the player may opt to play a provisional ball.
