

CHAMPIONS GATE GOLF CLUB International Course

1. **LIFT, CLEAN & PLACE (LCP):** When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less in the player's own fairway, the player may take free relief once [ball in play once addressed] by placing the original ball or another ball in and play from this relief area:
 - Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
 - Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: Within one club-length from the reference point.
 - Limits on Location of Relief Area: Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in the general area.
2. **HOLE #7 TEEING GROUND** The front most tee markers on Hole #7 shall define the teeing ground for that hole. These markers are normally found on the front left tee box adjacent to the hotel wave pool.
3. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR):** Any tire ruts in the General Area and any uncut fairway areas with green stakes and rope indicate soft conditions shall be deemed GUR.
4. **PENALTY AREAS:** In the absence of solid red or yellow penalty area boundary lines, all areas on each hole beyond the last cut of rough of any hole shall be deemed Lateral Penalty Areas. The Penalty Areas shall include any sand areas and "Effluent Water Disposal Areas" there.
5. **SPECIAL PROVISIONAL BALL ALLOWANCE ON HOLE #6:** On Hole #6, for balls thought to be lost in any Penalty Area, the option of playing a provisional ball shall be permitted. Any ball hit with trajectory toward a Penalty Area shall be deemed to have not crossed the General Area unless the player is virtually certain it had.
