EVENT SPECIFIC LOCAL RULES

1. LIFT, CLEAN & PLACE (LCP): When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area, cut to fairway height or less in the player's own fairway, or **also in Waste Area on left side of Hole #2**, the player may take free relief once [ball in play when finally addressed] by placing the original ball or another ball in and play from this relief area:

- **Reference Point:** Spot of the original ball.
- **Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point:** Within one club-length from the reference point.
- **Limits on Location of Relief Area:** Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in the **general** area. Where relief is granted within a Waste Area, the Location of Relief must remain in the Waste Area.

NOTE: A player's ball is deemed to be in the player's own fairway only if the player is "virtually certain" it is fact.

2. OUT OF BOUNDS (OB) White Out of Bounds (OB) stakes, automobile roadways, property fences/walls, **and 9" cylindrical green cable TV boxes at rear of residential properties adjacent to the golf course shall also define OB.**

3. **PENALTY AREAS** For each individual hole on the course, all unmaintained area beyond the last cut of rough shall be deemed Lateral Penalty Area unless otherwise marked.
4. **TEEING GROUNDS** On all holes, the back most tee markers on each hole shall define the teeing ground for that hole.
5. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (GUR)** All crevices or washout areas such as water erosion damage, and tire ruts shall be deemed GUR.

FOOTPRINTS in bunkers and waste areas shall be deemed GUR allowing for relief from obstruction to stance or swing.
