EVENT SPECIFIC LOCAL RULES

The back nine played twice consecutively shall comprise the stipulated round.

- 1. LIFT, CLEAN & PLACE (LCP)** When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area cut to fairway height or less and in the player's **own fairway**, the player may take free relief [ball in play once addressed] by placing the original ball or another ball in and play from this relief area:

Reference Point: Spot of the original ball;

Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: Within one club-length from the reference point;

Limits on Location of Relief Area: Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point, and must be in the general area. Relief for balls originating in a designated "Waste Area" is limited to that Waste Area.

Penalty for Playing from a Wrong Place under this Local Rule:**General Penalty.**

2. **PENALTY AREAS:**In the absence of solid red or yellow penalty area boundary lines, all areas on each hole beyond the last cut of rough shall be deemed Lateral Penalty Areas.
3. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** All tire ruts shall be deemed Ground Under Repair (GUR). Any damaged areas, spot sanded areas, newly laid sod or grass plugs on the any putting green shall be deemed GUR, Abnormal Course Condition. **FOOTPRINTS in bunkers shall be deemed GUR allowing for relief from obstruction to stance or swing.**
